

Breakfast Club Update

I hope you have been enjoying the summer and the lovely weather and a break from home learning. We are looking forward to welcoming all children back to school on Tuesday September 8th. As you will be aware, we have had to put into place a number of changes to enable school to function as normally as possible and to make it as safe as it can be for both our children and staff.

We will continue to offer a breakfast club but due to space, social distancing measures and year group bubbles we can only offer this to children from Reception to Year 6 and have a limited number of places. The following measures have been put in place:

- Places must be booked and paid for in advance
- Places are limited to 12 per year group – this number cannot be exceeded under any circumstances
- Bookings can be made and paid for through Eduspot (£2 per day, free to FSM/PP chn)
- Eduspot uses your school dinner money login
- Bookings can be made up to half a term in advance
- Breakfast club starts at 8am and children must arrive promptly via Key Stage 1 yard via the top gate on Rothbury Gardens.
- Children who arrive late cannot be admitted
- Anyone arriving who has not booked in advance will not be admitted
- Children will be met at the Key Stage 1 doors by a member of staff
- Children will be asked to wash their hands on arrival and escorted to the hall by a member of staff
- In the hall, children will be sitting with children in their year group, each year group will have their own set of resources and breakfast utensils
- Children will be collected by their teaching assistants at the end of the session
- All the usual choices of breakfast options will be available
- **If you are unable to book a place, it is parental responsibility to make alternative arrangements**
