What are Autism Hubs?

Gateshead Autism Hubs offer parents and carers of autistic children and young people (0-25 years) information, advice and support on a range of challenges that can impact autistic young people and their families. The Hubs provide multi-agency drop-in sessions, parent support groups, and training for parents, carers, and professionals.

The Hubs can also offer information and signposting on related co-occurring conditions, such as: FASD, ADHD, Sensory Differences, Social and Communication Differences, Mental Health, and Learning Disabilities. Gateshead Autism Hubs are free to access for parents and carers. An autism diagnosis is not required to access support.

What can I expect?

Once we receive your referral, a member of our admin team will be in touch to register you. They will provide you with all the information about aspects of the service you can access, including drop in sessions available across Gateshead.
