Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope this letter finds you well as we begin the new school year. I am writing to remind you of our school policy regarding jewellery, specifically earrings.

As outlined in our school policy, earrings are not permitted to be worn by children during the school day. This includes clear spacers or retainers, which are also not allowed under our guidelines.

I recognise that some families may not have been able to arrange ear piercing at the beginning of the summer holidays, and I understand that newly pierced ears require special care. Therefore, for children with **newly pierced ears only**, earrings may be worn until October half term at the latest.

During this period, earrings must be completely covered with tape or plasters for safety reasons, and children will not be able to participate in PE lessons while wearing earrings. Please cover earrings before arriving at school.

After the October half term break, all earrings must be removed during school hours without exception. This policy is in place to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all our children, particularly during physical activities and play times.

I appreciate your understanding and co-operation in helping us maintain a safe learning environment for everyone. If you have any questions or concerns about this policy, please do not hesitate to contact the school office.
