Dear Parents/Carers

Monday is going to be a busy day with Sports Day and the children receiving their end of year reports. They will come home with these at the end of the day. Enclosed within the report will be information about your child's class and teacher for next year.

As you will be aware, due to national fluctuations in pupil numbers across the school and the extremely tight budgets schools are facing nationally, we have been required to adapt our class structure in recent years.

The structure for the coming academic year is as follows:

- Nursery AM/PM session
- Reception – one cohort across two teachers
- Two Year 1 classes
- Two Year 2 classes
- Mrs Camm's class
- Three mixed Year 3/4 classes
- One Year 5 class
- Two Year 6 classes

Whilst there have been some changes since last year. To reassure you, our curriculum is mapped out on a two-year cycle to allow for changes such as this. The class lists for September reflect a balanced mix of children with any changes kept to a minimum.

Current Year 2 children will stay with the Year 2 children in their current class and join an existing group of Year 3 children.

In September, we will hold an Open Evening for you to speak to your child's new class teacher where you can find out more about their daily routine, the curriculum and expectations for their new year group. This will be an opportunity for you to meet school leaders and our family support worker.

The Open Evening will be a drop-in event on Wednesday 20 September between 3:45PM and 5:30PM. Please join us when you can between these times.
