



Homework Information

Our children are showing a great attitude to their learning and they work hard throughout the day. For some subject areas, the chance to practice at home is essential to help them become more confident and fluent. Our homework focuses predominantly on reading, spelling and maths.

We appreciate the support from our families and recognise the huge impact practice at home has with our children’s progress.

The homework expectations in each year group are as follows:

All year groups will bring home a library book either weekly or fortnightly—this is a free choice and some children may need adult support to access the reading within. Please return their book in order to take another home.

Read Write Inc (RWI) books must be returned each week to allow teachers to send the next book home. These books are extremely expensive and must be returned.

Years 3-6, a homework club will be available on a Wednesday and Thursday lunchtime for any children who have not got access to online learning at home. This is to support children; they will not be kept in as a consequence.

Please note, as preparation for secondary school, our Year 6 children must complete homework unless exceptional circumstances arise. Please inform your child’s class teacher of any circumstances.

The Home Learning Bags for Reception and Year 1 will be sent out in week 5. Please use the link below to sign up for the loan of your bag. These will be returned to school in summer term.
